

Checklist for Litter Free Sporting Events



PREPARATION

- Review bin count and location at the start of the season**
 - Do you have enough bins?
 - Are bins in the right locations?
 - Are bins visible across the grounds?
- CONTACT COUNCIL TO ASSIST**
- Review signs during season**
 - Do you need signs to make bins visible?
 - Do you need signs to direct people to bins?
- CONTACT COUNCIL TO ASSIST**
- Review canteen operations**
 - Do you need a recycling bin for bulk cardboard and packaging?
 - Do you have a Return and Earn collection point for drink bottles?

AT THE EVENT

- Operations during game day**
 - Is someone monitoring bins during game day?
 - Do you have a Return and Earn collection point for drink bottles?
- Canteen leads by example**
 - Only provide straws when requested
 - Use serviettes instead of food containers where possible
 - Consider using bottled sauces with pump tops
- Drink bottles**
 - Collect Return and Earn bottles and feed funds back to the club

LITTER AND WASTE PREVENTION

- Do you have litter pledges on display at your home ground?
- Beautification of the home ground is included in the club events calendar
- Consider canteen suppliers who have minimal packaging
- Send reminders to your visiting clubs to set expectations for your litter free event
- Encourage players to bring reusable drink bottles and refill at the grounds
