- Obtain the permission of the landowner to nominate the property.
- Obtain the landowner's permission for judges to view the property from the street and allow Council officers to take a photo of the property from the street.
- **The nominee must provide photos of the property with the nomination form.**
- The decision of the Judging Panel will be final.
- If you have not heard back from Council by September 2021 regarding your nomination, then you can consider that your nomination was unsuccessful this time.
- All nominations and supporting material will be retained by Cumberland City Council and may be used for promotional and other purposes at the discretion of Council.
- It is expected that nominations will be competitive and there is no guarantee that you will receive an award if you make a nomination.
- Details regarding individual scores given by Judges for each nomination and award will not be released to nominees or the public.
