**Nominations open on Monday, 8 March 2021 and close on Friday, 30 April 2021.**

This category is open to a wide range of ages, with two divisions of entry; Junior Division for children in Year 5 to Year 8 (inclusive) and Open Division for all members of the community aged 15 years and above.

The theme for this category is “Connecting People, Places and the Past” and it celebrates all aspects of heritage including buildings, landscapes, sacred sites, artefacts and artworks, film, stories, people, groups, and ceremonies.

Participants are invited to research any aspect of heritage that brings to life all chapters of culture and history within Cumberland City, telling the stories of diverse and distinctive experiences that make up our communities.

Entrants are encouraged to be innovative and present their work in either a written format or visual format that utilises a creative technique such as digital, photography, mixed, or traditional (e.g. pencil charcoal or paint) mediums. Entries must show originality and primary research.

## Conditions of Entry for Nominees

### 1. Assessment Criteria

- The work makes a substantial contribution towards preserving, enhancing, interpreting or highlighting Cumberland City's heritage.
- The individual or group has made an extraordinary effort with regards to heritage.
- The work raises awareness and understanding of Cumberland City's heritage.
- The work displays an outstanding appreciation of heritage.

### 2. Nominees' Responsibilities

- Fill in the standard nomination form.
- Submit the details of the work with the completed nomination form.
- Ensure that the nominee is at least 14 years of age.
- Ensure that the work is related to an element of Cumberland's history and heritage.
- Ensure that the owner of the work has given permission for the work to be nominated for this award.
- Only one entry is permitted per person or organisation (i.e. historical society, research group, etc.).
- Content must demonstrate that an element of primary research has been undertaken, that the content is the original work of the entrant, and any information sources are appropriately referenced.

### 3. Conditions of Entry

- The decision of the Judging Panel will be final.
- If you have not heard back from Council by September 2021 regarding your nomination, then you can consider that your nomination was unsuccessful this time.
- All nominations and supporting material will be retained by Cumberland City Council and may be used for promotional and other purposes at the discretion of Council.
- It is expected that nominations will be competitive and there is no guarantee that you will receive an award if you make a nomination.
- Details regarding individual scores given by Judges for each nomination and award will not be released to nominees or the public.
- By entering these awards, you agree to these conditions.
